

Notification of works

Electricity construction and connection for the Eyre Peninsula desalination project May - December 2025

As part of the Eyre Peninsula desalination project, works have started to connect the facility to the local electricity distribution network. In partnership with SA Power Networks, this includes the installation of underground cables from the Port Lincoln City substation on Sleaford Terrace through Tennant Street, Verran Terrace and Windsor Avenue, and overhead powerlines from Stamford Terrace and Windsor Avenue through to the desalination plant via Greyhound Road. A short section of underground cable will also be installed along St Andrews Drive, near the wastewater treatment plant entrance.



Initial civil works on St Andrews Drive will be undertaken by M&M Civil from **Monday 5 May to Friday 30 May**, with works occurring weekdays between 7am and 5pm. These will involve trenching and laying foundations for four new Stobie poles.

While access to the Port Lincoln boat ramp car park may experience short delays due to traffic management, Council facilities will remain accessible.

Additional underground cabling works, delivered by Equipped Civil from 12 May to August 2025, will follow a route from the substation through nearby streets. Some night works at intersections may be required, and local property owners will be advised in advance if affected. Powerline and overhead works will follow from June to December 2025.

SA Power Networks is committed to minimising construction impacts such as noise, vibration, and traffic disruptions. Customers that may be affected will be notified directly.
