Reactivating the Repat

Over \$69 million will be invested into a revitalised Repat Health Precinct, with the focus of the site being state-of-the-art services to care for brain and spinal rehabilitation patients and older mental health and dementia patients.





The revitalised Repat Health Precinct will be a critical part of South Australia's future health system.

Statewide specialised rehabilitation

Spinal unit:

The former rehabilitation wards will be redeveloped to provide for a new 23 bed statewide spinal injury ward.

Brain unit:

A new state-of-the-art brain injury facility will be built to provide a 26 bed specialist inpatient ward.






Dementia Village

An 18 bed specialised facility will care for some of the most vulnerable residents suffering extreme behavioural and psychological symptoms of dementia. This will form part of a dedicated dementia village, including 60 places of care for people with dementia who have complex





Town Square

A town square will be developed to create a community hub and open outdoor flexible use space including a new wheelchair training / sports gymnasium, refurbishment of the SPF Hall and a new café.
