Draft Recreation and Open Space Strategy

The draft Recreation and Open Space Strategy provides the overarching framework and strategic direction for recreation and open space planning and development in the Snowy Monaro Region for the next ten years.

Many of our facilities are ageing and don't meet modern standards. Finding resources to maintain and renew infrastructure to meet our community's expectations is a significant challenge. This Strategy aims to determine the solutions, priorities and actions for a sustainable, high quality and well utilised recreation network.

Key components of this project include

- An up-to-date inventory of our recreation facilities and open spaces
- Analysis of demographic indicators and recreational trends, demands and needs for the future
- Review background documents and strategies that influence recreation planning
- Consultation with stakeholders and the wider community
- Development of an action plan that identifies what needs to be done, at which level of priority and by who

What we need to consider

- There is an ageing population and a desire for more informal and accessible recreation facilities such as shared pathways for walking and cycling
- The Snowy 2.0 project has had some influence on the local demographic with a small number of staff living in the village year-round
- According to the 2021 census data the age group that changed the most since 2016 was 35-39 year olds
- In 2021, the largest age group was 60-64 year olds. It is estimated that there will be a 40 percent increase in the population of retirement age over the next ten years

Proposed actions

- The Regional Trails Masterplan recommends investigating the development of recreational trails along the Eucumbene foreshore
- Prepare a Masterplan for multi-use sites such as Adaminaby Showground
- Investigate opportunities to develop Seymour Park as a local park central to residential area
- Review the scope of work for the Old Adaminaby Boat Ramp upgrade
- Review all undeveloped open spaces

Community consultation April 2023	Draft Recreation and Open Space Strategy on public exhibition - April 2023. Open for public comment from March 20 - 28 April 2023. Community pop-up session throughout March - April. Online information session - April 27
Feedback under review May - June 2023	Feedback from the community will inform further amendments or changes to the Strategy
Final Strategy adopted June 2023	The final Strategy will be presented to Council for adoption
