
Section 4: Location of the Precinct

This section aims to help Council understand what is important to the community in terms of the location of The Precinct.

Three locations are currently being considered to host The Precinct, each location providing unique benefits and challenges for a key future community destination.

These locations include:

- 1. Armstrong Road ('Gillespie' Land) this site is Council-owned community land and is approximately 17 acres. It is located at 21 Armstrong Road, Encounter Bay between Victor Harbor Golf Club (to the east) and Canton Place (to the west).
- 2. Lot 202 this site is Council-owned community land. It is irregular shaped and approximately 27 acres. The parcel of land with frontages to George Main Road, Ewen Terrace and Armstrong Road, Encounter Bay. It is located in between the Inman River, Victor Harbor Recreation Centre, TAFE SA, SA Police and the Encounter Centre.
- 3. Adelaide Road this site is owned by Encounter Lutheran College and is 69 acres in size. It is a high-profile site, located at the corner of Adelaide Road and Waterport Road at the entry to the Victor Harbor township.
