Proposed Changes to Route 390

A change is proposed to bring Route 390 onto its long term alignment in Banksia Grove, as previously coordinated with local government and the developer.

Under the proposal, Viridian Drive would no longer be serviced by Route 390. Passengers currently using Route 390 on Viridian Drive can alternatively take the same service from Joondalup Drive.

The proposed new alignment of Route 390 is via Elderiana Link and Grandis Boulevard to a new terminus on Forever Boulevard.

There are no proposed changes to the operating hours or frequency of Route 390.

Route 390 proposed alignment to new Forever Bvd terminus.

Route 390 proposed to no longer operate on Viridian Drive.

Route 390 will maintain its existing alignment between Joondalup Stn and Elderiana Link.
