Residents within the Northern Rivers are invited to submit their designs to be digitally printed and installed on the side panels of the three new bins.

The competition is open to all ages and artistic levels living in the Northern Rivers Region. Community groups, designers as well as families, professional or first time artists, school students, kids and elders can all get involved.

We are looking for artwork that reflects the character and uniqueness of Lismore, the only restriction being that the designs utilise the provided colour palette, which will compliment and be coherent with the new creative way finding strategy.

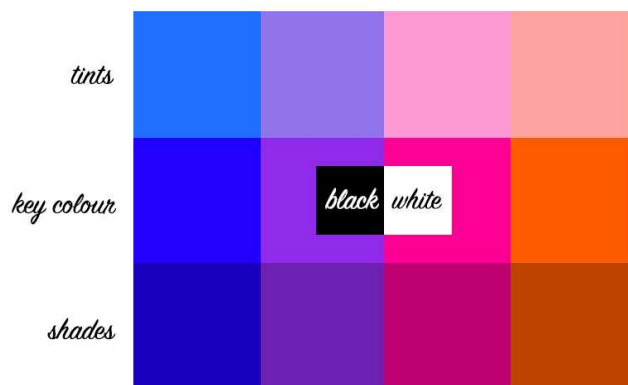
