



Have your say – Safety improvements at Mamre Road and Kerrs Road Intersection

Community notification

Transport for NSW is planning safety improvements at the Mamre Road and Kerrs Road intersection. These improvements are part of a larger project to make roads safer around the new Western Sydney Airport.

Have your say

The community is invited to provide feedback on the proposed improvements at the Mamre Road and Kerrs Road intersection. Currently, this is a T-intersection with no traffic lights and no turning lanes on either of the roads.

Transport proposes to improve this intersection by adding traffic lights, medians and dedicated left and right turn lanes.

The proposed traffic lights will enhance safety for all road users, while the new lane arrangements will improve traffic flow through the intersection.

The proposed improvements are open for feedback until 18 December 2024. To submit your feedback, please refer to our contact details on the back page.

Crash history

Between 2017 and 2021, the Western Sydney Airport Precinct saw 201 recorded crashes, including 141 injury crashes and 3 fatalities. Crashes at intersections made up over a third of these incidents, showing the need for safety improvements.

At Mamre Road and Kerrs Road, there have been several rear-end and turning related crashes, reinforcing the importance of this project.

What will this mean for you?

As the area grows with the Western Sydney Airport, this upgrade will:

- Improve traffic flow and support an increase in local traffic.
- Make it safer for all road users
- Use new technology to better manage traffic.

What happens next?

All comments received during consultation for the proposed design will be considered in decision making and development of the concept design.

We will keep community members and stakeholders informed of the progress throughout delivery of the project.
