Kilmore is a large peri-urban town that is experiencing sigificant residential growth.

To ensure that new residential development recognises and responds to valued characteristics and attributes of the town, Mitchell Shire Council has prepared a Draft Neighbourhood Character Study for Kilmore. The study will inform future changes to planning controls in the Mitchell Planning Scheme.

About the Study

Council has prepared a Draft Neighbourhood Character Study for Kilmore using the feedback from the Stage One Consultation.

The study looks at all residential zoned areas of Kilmore, and aims to guide new development, making sure it fits in the area's existing or preferred character. We have identified six Neighbourhood Character Areas in Kilmore.

We want to understand what is important to you about your neighbourhood and if we have got it right. You can get involved by reading the draft study and sharing your thoughts.
